Donations for Hurricane Maria Victims in Puerto Rico and The U.S. Virgin Islands

The United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR), given the significant and wide-ranging losses in several parts of the nation, has responded to each of these areas with existing resources. Accordingly, UMCOR has not assigned a new donation number to the United States territories of Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Instead, UMCOR's existing "U.S. and U.S. Territory Disaster Relief Fund, #901670, is being used to received used to receive your special gifts for these and other hard-hit areas of the United States. You can be assured that dollars you already have given, and dollars given to this appeal, are reaching our fellow Americans and sisters and brothers in Christ in the U.S. territories of Puerto Rico and The U.S. Virgin Islands. Accordingly, if you desire to make a special gift to the ongoing Hurricane relief of UMCOR in these areas, make your check payable to "AUMC" and place "UMCOR #901670" in the check memo. Also, PLEASE DO NOT use a regular or pew offering envelope, but use a blank envelope, marking it, "UMCOR." Thank you and God's blessings.

Is God Calling You To Be Part of a Hurricane Response Team?
The United Methodist Church mobilizes "Volunteer in Missions" and "Emergency Response Teams" to natural disaster sites/regions. Have you sensed a tug to be part of such an effort? If so, prayerfully consider the opportunities listed below. Contact Curt Knouse for details and conversation as noted below.

Florida -- The **Florida Annual Conference** needs teams right away. All volunteers will be accepted, regardless of ERT training. Individuals and teams are encouraged to register and should expect to be deployed in the southern part of the state.

Texas -- The **Texas Annual Conference** (Houston and north Gulf Coast) is very much in need of volunteer help. In the last few weeks, teams have mucked out and gutted more than 6000 homes, but they are still finding communities where the damage has not been assessed. Volunteers should be over age 18, Safe Sanctuaries certified, and at least one member of the team should be ERT trained.

Rio Texas -- The Rio Texas Conference (Corpus Christi and south Gulf Coast area) are taking **ERTs** for approximately another 6 weeks and are accepting reservations for Long-Term Recovery teams after that. There are two different registration links, so make sure you use the right one! Additionally, they are looking for individuals who would be willing to volunteer for longer periods of time with site management and volunteer coordination. Contact Eugene Hileman (aeihileman@riotexas.org) if you can help with this ministry.

Puerto Rico and US Virgin Islands (US Territories) -- This is still a government-controlled situation. They are in emergency relief phase and it is NOT appropriate for volunteers to go yet. We will update you as this situation changes. UMCOR is releasing grants to Puerto Rico quickly and talking daily with the Bishop and other church leaders on the islands.
