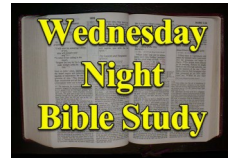
On Going Study for Men's-Open

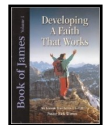

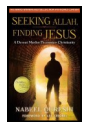
6 Weeks– Begins Jan. 11th ends Feb . 15th

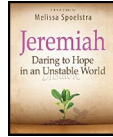


Jeremiah - Daring to Hope in an Unstable World
