Dear Friend in the Messiah,

Jesus' followers are called to sound different than the din of the world.

Jesus' followers are to be revealed by the words that proceed from our hearts, the humility that envelopes our conduct, and the trust in God's great faithfulness that overrides any and every one of our fears.

At Aldersgate United Methodist Church we worship alongside, we serve alongside, we study Scripture alongside, and we sit across the table from individuals who voted for different candidates in the election. Sure, our diversity here might not be as great as in other congregations in other places, but there are differences that must be bridged by the Oneness that we claim to hold in common: Jesus Christ.

Within two days of the General Election, I as Aldersgate Church's pastor had four separate conversations initiated with me concerning things being said by sisters and brothers in Christ about the election – both in person and via social media postings.

"What are we to do?"

We should do what we should have been doing all along. 1) Pray for our president, whether you voted for him or not. 2) Respect the purpose and authority of government. 3) Recognize that a faith community is not comprised of like-minded individuals, only united in our common need for God's saving grace in Jesus. 4) When you hear un-Christ-like words or comments (or see them appear on your screen from behind their screen), challenge them immediately! "How is that Christ-like?" "Where's that coming from?" "We're called to be better than that." 5) Remember to inspect your own biases in doing #4, but don't fail to challenge out of fear that you're not perfect yet. That's too easy of an excuse. 6) And, keep on keeping on. God is faithful. Do not grow weary in doing good. 7) Pray for one another – and remember to include yourself in that prayer for grace and Wisdom.

These are the things that we should have been doing all along, but it's especially incumbent upon us now to be practicing what the Lord requires: do justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God.

You'll notice I'm not quoting Scriptures to support each point. Indeed, there are Scriptural supports for each one, but more importantly, there is our Christ who has destined us for living like that.

Carl's Corner

- 1. During the past few months we have been experiencing numerous issues with our Fire/Security system. Upon further investigation it was determined that we had a faulty fire communication panel as well as a faulty smoke detector located in the side room of the sanctuary. A proposal to make repairs was received and approved. Work was completed and passed inspection on 11-7-16 and our Fire/Security system is now fully operational with no further issues.
- 2. Preparations are underway for the upcoming winter months ahead. Snow stakes have been installed in the parking lot area. Checking the building envelope for air leakage and making repairs or insulating areas of concern is ongoing. We are communicating with our snow removal contractor the importance of snow and ice removal to accommodate preschool activities and other Church activities.
- 3. Work was performed by in house personnel on trimming of many trees located around the facility. This was labor intensive and there are a few more trees that need to be trimmed to complete the project. Special thanks to Mike Lebo who was part of making this happen.
- 4. In the past several weeks, we made a number repairs on the church van. If you use the van, please communicate any need you see for further repairs by entering the information on the Trip Log sheet. Thank you for doing what you can to keep it in good condition!
